When it comes to shopping, who doesn't like a good bargain? Discounts, sales, coupons, BOGO, clearance, you know what I mean. It makes you feel good when you save money and can use it toward something else—like your next ski trip.

Unfortunately, when we print and send paper copies of Ski Trails--like the one you might be reading at this moment, we are NOT saving money at all. In fact, ST is the biggest expense in club's budget (as published in the August edition).

Let's look at the numbers. About 350 members still request a mailed copy. This is significantly lower than it was a few years ago thanks to the hard work of former and current publicity directors and to those members who have opted out. A printed and mailed copy costs about \$2.00 per month. Not bad, your morning cup of coffee costs more. True... but in one year, that's \$24.00 per member or about \$8,400.00 total. Like all organizations, we have to make choices. At this time, we are still printing Ski Trails and are giving our members a choice whether or not to receive one. So here is what I am asking you to do. If you think you can forgo a paper copy, PLEASE opt for the online version. If you are still enjoying your hard copy, that's OK, but consider printing one out at home using your own printer. We can support other facets of the club with the savings such as: subsidizing vouchers, lessons programs, First Tracks, Winter Sports Night and other celebrations. We all know change is both difficult and productive. Be the change. I opted out a few years ago-why don't you join me?
